PLANTING ROSES

95% of your success with roses is determined at planting time!

RECIPE FOR SUCCESS WITH ROSES:

- Site - 6 hours of full sun at a minimum.
- Good soil drainage is a must (see soil mix below).
- Prepare planting hole properly (see below).
- Attention to watering, generous - but not swampy. Water regularly.
- Fertilize when you can see first bud color.
- Fertilize on a regular basis according to instructions on your fertilizer.

PLANTING HOLE: 3' wide x 1' deep, plant your container rose even with, or slightly higher than, surrounding soil.

SOIL MIX - Mix together well:

- ½ Native Soil (no matter how bad it is)
- ½ Soil Conditioner/Composted Cow Manure
- 1 Cup Lime (important, they love the calcium)
- 1 Cup Triple Phosphate (optional)
