All of our farm-grown vegetables are sustainably raised using natural and organically derived soils and fertilizers (such as kelp, earthworm castings, and oilseed extract), and we only use organic pest control methods, as needed. **Availability is dependent on weather and other factors.** When our homegrown veggie supply runs short, we occasionally bring in conventional vegetables and label them accordingly.

Basic Gardening Tips

Plant in fertile, well amended, well-draining soil in full sun. We carry many organic options to spruce up your soil. A soil test will tell you what nutrients your soil may need.

Cloudy days, or in the morning or evening, are a great time to plant. Handle seedlings carefully. Gently, yet firmly, tamp seedlings into the soil. You want the roots to come into contact with the soil.

Water thoroughly. **Liquid seaweed & fish fertilizer** is one of our favorites to water in, available in our Garden Shop.

Mulch will help to suppress weeds, conserve water, and improve the health of the soil. We carry hardwood mulch, pine bark mulch, and wheat straw.

Many people find raised beds to be easier to garden in, than the ground – especially with hard clay soil. Raised beds give you easy control over the soil, and can be easier on the back and knees. We do carry a **raised-bed soil mix**.

A **mini-hoop house** will help protect your plants from weather and pests. We carry fiberglass rods and floating row cover for building your own. See [Quick DIY Winter Protection Low Tunnel](#).
