Fall is a great time to plant cool season vegetables - fewer issues with bolting, pests, and weeds. Frosts can also impart a delicious sweet flavor. Our first frost is usually mid-October.

Basic Tips:

- Plant in fertile, well amended, well-draining soil in full sun. We carry many organic options to spruce up your soil. A soil test will tell you what nutrients your soil may need.
- Neptune's Harvest Fish & Seaweed organic liquid fertilizer is one of our favorites to water in, available in our Garden Shop.
- **Mulch** will help to suppress weeds, conserve water, and improve the health of the soil. We carry hardwood mulch, pine bark mulch, and wheat straw.
- A mini-hoop house will help protect your plants from weather and pests. We carry fiberglass rods and floating row cover (also in our Garden Shop) for building your own. The heaviest weight row cover will provide the most winter protection, to extend your growing season. See <u>Quick DIY Winter</u> <u>Protection Low Tunnel</u>.
