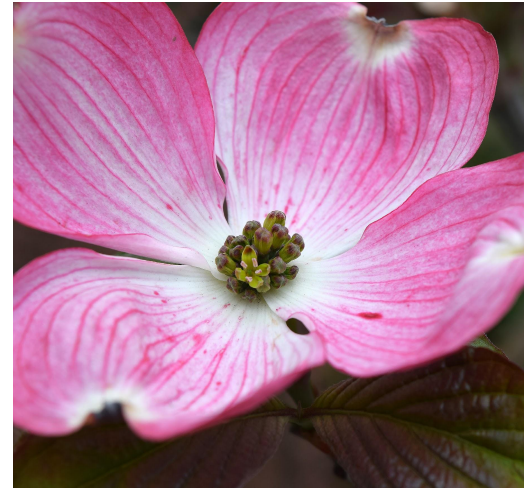


Native Perennials, Trees, & Shrubs
