# Perennials for Rock Gardens

## A Garden Guide

Rock garden and alpine perennial plants are chosen to complement rocks. These drought-tolerant plants are especially useful in or on stone walls or sloping banks with good drainage. Varieties listed will not be available at all times.



*Achillea millefolium* – Yarrow, 16-36", sun  
*Acorus sp.* – 12-18", sun to ½ day sun  
*Ajuga sp.* – Bugleweed, 6-10", shade to sun  
*Alyssum sp.* – Basket of Gold, 4-8", sun to ½ day sun  
*Anacyclus depressus* – Mt. Atlas Daisy, 3", sun  
*Anemone sp.* – Windflower, 12-16", part shade to ½ day sun  
*Aquilegia sp.* – Columbine, 6-12", part shade to ½ day sun  
*Arabis sp.* – Rockcress, 6-8", ½ day sun to sun  
*Armeria maritima* – Sea thrift, 4-8", sun to ½ day sun  
*Aubrieta sp.* – Rock Cress, 4-6", sun to ½ day sun  
*Bletilla sp.* – Hardy Orchid, 8-12", part shade  
*Campanula carpatica* – 6-12", part shade to sun  
*Campanula rotundifolia* – Scotch Bluebells 6-8", ½ day sun to sun  
*Carex sp.* – 6-24", sun to part shade

*Cerastium sp.* – Snow in the Summer, 6-12", sun  
*Ceratostigma sp.* – Plumbago, 8-10", part shade to sun  
*Chrysogonum sp.* – Green and Gold, 4-8", ½ day sun to shade  
*Convallaria sp.* – Lily Of The Valley, 12", ½ day sun to shade  
*Coreopsis auriculata* – Tickseed, 8-10", sun  
*Corydalis lutea*, 8-12", part shade to ½ day sun  
*Cymbalaria sp.* – Kenilworth Ivy, 4-6", part shade to shade  
*Delosperma sp.* – Iceplant, 4-6", sun  
*Dianthus sp.* – Sweet William, 12", sun to ½ day sun  
*Epimedium sp.* – Barrenwort, 8-10", shade to ½ day sun  
*Euphorbia sp.* – Spurge, 12", sun to ½ day sun  
*Galium sp.* – Sweet Woodruff, 6", part shade to ½ day sun  
*Gaillardia sp.* – Blanket Flower, 12-24", sun

- Gaultheria procumbens* – Creeping Wintergreen, 8-12", shade to ½ day sun
- Geranium sp.* – Cranesbill, 12", ½ day sun to sun
- Geum sp.* – Avens, 8", sun
- Hakonechloa macra aureola* – 12-16", ½ day sun to part shade
- Helleborus niger* – Christmas Rose, 8-12", shade to ½ day sun
- Helleborus orientalis* – Lenten Rose, 8-16", ½ day sun to shade
- Hemerocallis sp.* – Dwarf Daylily, 16-20", sun to ½ day sun
- Heuchera sp.* – Coral Bells, 8-12", part shade to sun
- Hosta sp.* – Plantain Lily, dwarf varieties, 6-12", part shade to ½ day sun
- Hypericum spp.* – St. John's Wort, 12-16", ½ day sun to sun
- Iberis sp.* – Candytuft, 6-10", sun to part shade
- Lamiastrum sp.* – False Lamium, 12", part shade to ½ day sun
- Lavandula x intermedia 'Provence'* – 12-16", sun
- Linaria sp.* – Toadflax, 18-24", sun to ½ day sun
- Liriope sp.* – Liliy turf, 8-10", shade to sun
- Lysimachia nummularia 'Aurea'* – 2-3", part shade to sun
- Mazus reptans* – 2-3", sun to ½ day sun
- Oenothera speciosa* – Pink Evening Primrose, 12", sun to ½ day sun
- Phlox subulata* – Thrift, 4-6", sun
- Polystichum acrostichoides* – Christmas Fern, 12-18", part shade to shade
- Primula sp.* – Primrose, 6-18", part shade to ½ day sun
- Pulmonaria officinalis*, – Lungwort, 10-12", part shade to ½ day sun
- Rubus hayata-koidzumii* – Creeping Raspberry, 4-8", sun to ½ day sun
- Santolina chamaecyparissus* – Lavender Cotton, 12", sun
- Saxifraga sp.* – Rock Foils, 8-10", sun
- Saponaria officinalis* – Soapwort, 4-8", sun to ½ day sun
- Sedum sp.* – Stonecrop, 2-12", sun
- Stachys byzantina* – Lamb's Ear, 6-12", sun to ½ day sun
- Thyme spp.* – Creeping & Wooly, 2-6", sun to ½ day sun
- Verbena canadensis* – Homestead Purple, 6-8", sun to ½ day sun

## BULBS

- Anemone De Caen* – Grecian Wild flowers, 4-6", sun to ½ day sun
- Allium schoenoprasum* – Chives 8-16", sun
- Crocus sp.* – 4-6", sun to ½ day sun
- Dwarf Daffodils – 6-12", sun to part shade
- Dwarf Iris – 12", sun to ½ day sun
