ANNUALS

Check out the great color that arrived this week in the Annual Dept. Fill in the gaps in your porch pots and add cheerful plants to your entryway and garden beds.

Mexican sage is in stock too and blooms late summer/fall with velvet-y purple blooms. This deer/rabbit resistant plant is loved by butterflies and hummingbirds – and makes a big splash in the garden!



Garden hint: Have your petunias stopped blooming? Cut them back and then fertilize them. You should have fresh blooms in a couple of weeks.

PERENNIALS

SHRUBS

Panicle Hydrangeas are budding and blooming now – always a welcome and cooling addition to the summer garden. Encore Azaleas are flowering, and Summersweet (*Clethra alnifolia*) is starting to bloom too. It is very fragrant and one of our favorite pollinator shrubs! Crape Myrtles are starting to flower along with Rose of Sharon. As always, incorporating evergreens into your landscape gives your garden year-round structure and interest.
